Hilton Precinct Meeting Notes

1. Bike Plan Renewal – Francis

- Renewal of the City of Fremantle Bike Plan (2019–2024) underway; community input needed.
- **Key discussion points:**
 - Hilton riding habits (routes, connections, destinations, facilities).
 - Safety and access issues for bikes in Hilton.
 - Awareness of Stream 2 Streets Alive Grant (up to \$100K) for potential Rennie Crescent bike safety improvements.
- **Actions:**
 - Angus and Francis to explore engagement at Hilton Primary School.
 - Emma to discuss with Bike Budz and Hilton Harvest, organise a community breakfast for engagement, and advertise via social media.

2. 40km/h Speed Trial

- Fremantle-wide 40km/h trial in effect; streets signs installed, and Google Maps updated.
- Feedback sought on Hilton experience so far.
- Trial duration: 12 months.
- Discussion points:
 - Are residents noticing improved safety and liveability?
 - Should the precinct advocate for permanent change?

3. Hilton Harvest & Hilton Precinct Spring Event – 20 Sept

- Band Old School (local) booked.
- Volunteer requirements:
 - **RSA card holders needed to help on the night.**

- Event is the precinct's main fundraising opportunity; community participation encouraged.
